

Dear friends,

since 2013 Red Cross Museum and the Red Cross Academy vogelsang ip are carrying out an RCRC International PEACE Camp.

Since then every year we are inviting young RCRC people from all over the world to take part in this two weeks event which is always taking place between end of July and end of August.

Participants are housed in the Youth-, Nature- an Environment House of our academy on the area of a former NAZI-Ordensburg in the far west of Germany, close to the Belgium and Dutch borders. For all international participants their stay in the camp is free and the camp health insurance is also covered by the German Red Cross. They only have to pay their travel expanses.

The program is divided into three parts.

study Peace, Humanity, Human Rights and the basics of International Humanitarian Law as well as the principles and international structure of our movement.

work Working in and around the five houses of the Red Cross Academy and the largest German Red Cross Museum (about 1.000 square meters RC exhibition).

visiting POI The former German capital Bonn and the Museum of German History, the city of Cologne with its famous cathedral and the river rhine, the city of Aachen with a trip to Belgium. The local and regional Red Cross headquarters and the battle of the bulge area of the second world war as well as relics of the „cold war“.

Usually, participants are attending only once but from our side they may join us more often to foster and strengthen the international team. In the last 13 years we had highly motivated young RCRC attendees from more than 45 countries and from four continents.

If any of your young members between 18 and 27 years of age are interested and you would like to send them please register via the REGISTRATION FORM on the website. We are prepared to take up to two people per country. Registration process will be closed at the end of June.






Red Cross Museum vogelsang ip

Description | Be part of the 14th international team in a workcamp of the German Red Cross!

Study, work and make friends meeting young people from all over the world and enjoy a great time.

You'll be staying in the „Transit 59“, a house for youth-nature- and environment of the German Red Cross situated in the center of the famous Eifel National Park close to the Belgium border.

Working Part | You and your team will be working in and around the houses of the Red Cross Museum the Red Cross Fluchthaus (Escaperoome) vogelsang ip and on the Mile for Future at the International Place Vogelsang IP.

Study Part | You will explore the history of the former "Nazi-Ordensburg" Vogelsang, the nature of the Eifel National Park, and the meaning of Peace, Humanity, and Europe, while also addressing the impact of climate change. All of this will be in cooperation with the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement.

Tourist Part | Visiting the former German capital Bonn, the Museum of German History, the famous City of Cologne at the river Rhine and the City of Aachen at the Belgium and Dutch border.

Requirements | Interest in different cultures, people, and peace work. Willingness for physical labor and sufficient English skills.

Some more information about your PEACE camp.

The Red Cross International PEACE Camp of the Red Cross Academy vogelsang ip is an international youth camp of the German Red Cross.

Participants between 18 and 26 years of age (German participants from 16 - 26) from all over the world do not necessarily have to be members of the movement. For older applicants exceptions are possible. Up to two participants per country will be accepted.

As a member of any national RC society please check with your society if there are any limitations or if your society is sending participants by your national headquarter.

If this is so you could send us your form through your national headquarter.

Otherwise you can just fill out your form.

If you are not a member of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent movement just fill out the registration form.

About three weeks after receiving your request we will send you an answer.

All accepted participants shall stay for the full duration of the camp. Incoming latest on the 9th of August and leaving on or after the 30th of August 2026.

You have to pay your travel expenses yourself but there are no camp fees for international participation and also the health insurance in the camp is covered by the German Red Cross.
